- 2 of the House of Representatives is amended by inserting
- 3 after the first sentence the following new sentence: "Ex-
- 4 Members of the House of Representatives, former Par-
- 5 liamentarians of the House, and former elected officers
- 6 and former elected minority employees of the House shall

- 1 also be excluded from admission to the Hall of the House
- 2 and rooms leading thereto if they have a direct personal
- 3 or pecuniary interest in any measure or matter under con-
- 4 sideration in any committee or subcommittee, unless that
- 5 measure or matter contains any provision that affects such
- 6 individuals solely because they belong to the class of ex-

7 Members.".
