RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the Secretary of State should seek certain commitments from the governments of Poland, Hungary, and the Czech Republic regarding the payment of insurance benefits owed to victims of the Nazis (and their beneficiaries and heirs) by those countries.

7 It is the sense of the House of Representatives that in

- 3 (1) raise the issue of insurance benefits owed to

- 8 cating their assets in the aftermath of World War

- counting of the total value of insurance company as-
- sets that were seized by their communist prede-
- cessors and to share all documents relevant to un-
- paid insurance claims that are in their possession;

- 17 (3) seek to secure a commitment from the gov-
- ernments of these countries to contribute to the pay-
- ment of these unpaid insurance claims in an amount
- 20 that reflects the present value of the assets seized by
- 21 the communist governments (and for which no com-
- pensation had previously been paid).
- 23 (b) Definition.—As used in this paragraph, the
- 24 term "victims of the Nazis" means persons persecuted
- 25 during the period beginning on March 23, 1933 and end-

- 1 ing on May 8, 1945, by, under the direction of, on behalf
- 2 of, or under authority granted by the Nazi government

3 of Germany or any nation allied with that government.
