Mr. TIAHRT submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths vote to increase the minimum wage.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 5 of rule XXI of the Rules of
2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the
3 end the following new paragraph:

4 “(e) No bill, joint resolution, amendment, or con-
5 ference report carrying a minimum wage increase shall be
6 considered as passed or agreed to unless so determined
7 by a vote of not less than three-fifths of the Members vot-
8 ing. For purposes of the preceding sentence, the term
9 ‘minimum wage increase’ means any amendment to sec-

tion 6 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to in-
crease the minimum wage.”.
