Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths vote to increase the minimum wage.

- 1 Resolved, That clause 5 of rule XXI of the Rules of
- 2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following new paragraph:
- 4 "(e) No bill, joint resolution, amendment, or con-
- 5 ference report carrying a minimum wage increase shall be
- 6 considered as passed or agreed to unless so determined
- 7 by a vote of not less than three-fifths of the Members vot-
- 8 ing. For purposes of the preceding sentence, the term
- 9 'minimum wage increase' means any amendment to sec-

- 1 tion 6 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to in-
- 2 crease the minimum wage.".
