- 3 the end the following:
- 4 "(8) The report of a committee accompanying each
- 5 bill or joint resolution of a public character shall contain
- 6 a detailed analysis of the probable impact of the bill or

- 1 resolution on children, including the impact on the number
- 2 of children who are hungry or homeless.".
- 3 (b) The amendment made by this resolution shall
- 4 apply to bills and resolutions reported after the ninetieth
- 5 day beginning after the date of adoption of this resolution.
