

H. Res. 90

In the House of Representatives, U.S.,

March 12, 1997.

Resolved, That upon the adoption of this resolution it shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 89) requesting the President to submit a budget for fiscal year 1998 that would balance the Federal budget by fiscal year 2002 without relying on budgetary contingencies. The resolution shall be considered as read for amendment. The resolution shall be debatable for two hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on the Budget or their designees. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the resolution to final adoption without intervening motion except one motion to recommit. The motion to recommit may include instructions only if offered by the minority leader or a designee.

If including instructions, the motion to recommit shall be debatable for five minutes by its proponent and five minutes by an opponent.
