RESOLUTION

Fixing the daily hour of meeting for the One Hundred Fifth Congress.

Resolved, That unless otherwise ordered, before Monday, May 12, 1997, the daily meetings of the House shall be at 2 p.m. on Mondays; at 11 a.m. on Tuesdays and Wednesdays; and at 10 a.m. on all other days of the week; and that from Monday, May 12, 1997, until the end of the first session, the daily meetings of the House shall be at noon on Mondays; at 10 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays; and at 9 a.m. on all other days of the week.
