A BILL

To suspend the rate of duty with respect to certain chemicals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DUTY SUSPENSIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Harmonized Tariff Schedule
5 of the United States is amended—

6 (1) in subheading 2906.11.00 (relating to dl
7 menthol), by striking “2.1%” and inserting “Free”;
8 and

9 (2) in subheading 2906.21.00 (relating to
10 benzyl alcohol), by striking “5.9%” and inserting
11 “Free”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that
4 is 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
