A BILL

For the relief of Marina Khalina and her son, Albert
Miftakhov.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Marina Khalina and her son, Albert
7 Miftakhov, shall be held and considered to have been law-
8 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
9 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
10 payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Marina
3 Khalina and her son, Albert Miftakhov, as provided in this
4 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer
5 to reduce by the appropriate number during the current
6 fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas available
7 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
8 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
9 1153(a)).
