A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to correct the tariff treatment of costumes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COSTUMES AND PIECES OR COMPONENTS**

4 **THEREOF.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—

6 (1) The U.S. notes for chapter 61 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States are
8 amended by adding at the end the following:

9 “11. Articles covered by this chapter shall include
10 costumes and pieces or components thereof.”.

1 (2) The U.S. notes for chapter 62 of the Har-
 2 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States are
 3 amended by adding at the end the following:

4 “10. Articles covered by this chapter shall include
 5 costumes and pieces or components thereof.”.

6 (3) U.S. note 1(e) for chapter 95 of the Har-
 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
 8 amended to read as follows:

9 “(e) “Sports clothing, fancy dress, or costumes and
 10 pieces or components thereof, of textile, of chapter 61 or
 11 62.”.

12 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

13 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to arti-
 14 cles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
 15 tion, on or after the 15th day after the date of enactment
 16 of this Act.
