- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Interstate System Im-
- 5 provement Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. SET ASIDE FOR 4R PROJECTS.
- 7 Section 118(c)(2)(A) of title 23, United States Code,
- 8 is amended—
- 9 (1) in the first sentence—

1	(A) by striking "\$54,000,000" and all that
2	follows through "1997" and inserting
3	" $\$800,000,000$ for each fiscal year"; and
4	(B) by striking "any highway designated
5	as a part of the Interstate System under section
6	139 and";
7	(2) by striking the second sentence; and
8	(3) in the last sentence, by striking "The re-
9	mainder of such" and inserting "The".
