- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Victim Protection Act
- 5 of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. HABEAS CORPUS RELIEF LIMITATION.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 2243 of title 28, United
- 8 States Code, is amended in the last paragraph by inserting
- 9 before the period at the end the following: ", except that
- 10 the court shall not prohibit the retrial of the person de-

- 1 tained, unless the court finds an infringement of the dou-
- 2 ble jeopardy, speedy trial, or ex post facto rights of the
- 3 person, or finds that the law under which the person was
- 4 convicted violates the Constitution. In the event of a re-
- 5 trial of the person detained, the trial shall be conducted
- 6 in accordance with the findings of the court".
- 7 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by this
