A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to extend the discretionary bridge program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Highway Bridge Im-
- 5 provement Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. DISCRETIONARY BRIDGE PROGRAM.
- 7 Section 144(g) of title 23, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by striking paragraph (1) and inserting the fol-
- 9 lowing:
- 10 "(1) Discretionary bridge program.—

"(A) Set aside.—For each fiscal year, be-
fore any apportionment is made under sub-
section (e), the Secretary shall set aside
\$800,000,000 from the funds authorized to
carry out this section.

"(B) USE OF SET ASIDE.—The amount set aside under subparagraph (A) shall be available for obligation in the same manner and to the same extent as the sums apportioned under subsection (e), except that the amount shall be available for obligation at the discretion of the Secretary.".
