- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP.

- 2 (a) CITIZENSHIP STATUS.—Upon the filing of an ap-
- 3 plication for a certificate of citizenship and upon being ad-
- 4 ministered the oath of renunciation and allegiance de-
- 5 scribed in section 337(a) of the Immigration and National-
- 6 ity Act, Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas shall be held and
- 7 considered to be a citizen of the United States from birth
- 8 pursuant to section 301(g) of the Immigration and Na-
- 9 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1401(g)) and shall be furnished
- 10 by the Attorney General with a certificate of citizenship.
- 11 (b) Supersedes Existing Law.—This section su-
- 12 persedes the parental physical presence requirement in
- 13 section 301(g) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
- 14 U.S.C. 1401(g)) and any other provision of law.
