# A BILL

To require the establishment of a research and grant program for the eradication or control of Pfiesteria piscicida and other aquatic toxins.

- 4 SEC. 2. PFIESTERIA AND OTHER AQUATIC TOXINS RE-
- 5 SEARCH AND GRANT PROGRAM.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Envi-
- 7 ronmental Protection Agency, the Secretary of Commerce
- 8 (acting through the Director of the National Marine Fish-
- 9 eries Service of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Ad-
- 10 ministration), the Secretary of Health and Human Serv-
- 11 ices (acting through the Director of the National Institute
- 12 of Environmental Health Sciences and the Director of the
- 13 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention), and the Sec-
- 14 retary of Agriculture shall—
- 15 (1) establish a research program for the eradi-
- 16 eation or control of Pfiesteria piscicida and other

- 22 (b) Grants.—In carrying out subsection (a)(2), the

- 25 (1) North Carolina State University in Raleigh,
- North Carolina, for the establishment of an Applied

Aquatic Ecology Center and for research conducted by the Center relating to aquatic toxins;

(2) the University System of Maryland and the Agricultural Research Center in Beltsville, Maryland, for the establishment of a cooperative Agro-Ecosystem Center for research and demonstration projects related to aquatic toxins, such as Pfiesteria piscicida, including projects that relate to dietary, waste management, and other alternative-use related strategies that reduce the undesirable nutrient and other chemical content from waste into waterways; and

(3) the Virginia Institute of Marine Science of the College of William and Mary in Gloucester Point, Virginia, for the establishment of a Marine Pathology and Applied Ecology Center and for research conducted by the Center relating to the effect of algal toxins on marine fish and shellfish and to understanding human influences on estuarine planktonic communities with an emphasis on harmful algal species, except that a portion of the grants made under this paragraph shall be allocated to Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Virginia, for research support.

(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is 1 authorized to be appropriated such sums as are necessary to carry out this section, of which not less than— 3 4 \$1,883,619 for fiscal year 1998, and \$655,890 for fiscal year 1999, shall be used to earry 5 6 out subsection (b)(1); 7 (2) \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1998 8 and 1999 shall be used to carry out subsection 9  $\frac{(b)(2)}{(b)}$ ; and (3) \$1,750,000 for fiscal year 1998, and 10 11 \$545,000 for fiscal year 1999, shall be used to earry 12 out subsection (b)(3). SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 14 This Act may be cited as the "Pfiesteria Research Act of 1997". 15 SEC. 2. PFIESTERIA AND OTHER AQUATIC TOXINS RE-17 SEARCH AND GRANT PROGRAM. 18 (a) In General.—The Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency, the Secretary of Commerce (acting through the Director of the National Marine Fisheries 21 Service of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration), the Secretary of Health and Human Services (acting through the Director of the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences and the Director of the Centers

1 for Disease Control and Prevention), and the Secretary of 2 Agriculture shall— 3 (1) establish a research program for the eradi-4 cation or control of Pfiesteria piscicida and other 5 aquatic toxins; and (2) make grants to colleges, universities, and 6 other entities in affected States for the eradication or 7 control of Pfiesteria piscicida and other aquatic tox-8 9 ins. (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is 10 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section 11 \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1998 and 1999.
