## A BILL

To provide that the Federal medical assistance percentage for any State or territory shall not be less than 60 percent.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Medical As-
- 5 sistance Percentage Equity Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN MINIMUM FMAP.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 1905(b) of the Social Se-
- 8 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(b)) is amended by striking
- 9 "50 per centum" each place it appears and inserting "60
- 10 per centum".

- 1 (b) Conforming Amendments.—Section
- 2 1101(a)(8) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 3 1301(a)(8)) is amended—
- 4 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "less than
- 5 50 per centum" and inserting "less than 60 per cen-
- 6 tum"; and
- 7 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking "50 per
- 8 centum" and inserting "60 per centum".

### 9 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
- 11 take effect on the first day of the fiscal year quarter that
- 12 begins after the date of enactment of this Act.
