A BILL

For the relief of Saeed Rezai.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Saeed Rezai shall be held and considered
- 7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
- 8 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
- 9 this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Saeed
- 12 Rezai as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State shall

- 1 instruct the proper officer to reduce by one number during
- 2 the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
- 3 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
- 4 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality

5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
