Mr. BYRD (for himself and Mr. MOYNIHAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred jointly pursuant to the order of August 4, 1977, as modified by the order of April 11, 1986, to the Committees on the Budget and Governmental Affairs, with instructions that if one Committee reports, the other Committee have thirty days to report or be discharged

A BILL

To repeal the Line Item Veto Act of 1996.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF THE LINE ITEM VETO ACT OF 1996.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Line Item Veto Act (Public
5 Law 104–130) and the amendments made by that Act are
6 repealed.

7 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The Impoundment Control Act
8 of 1974 shall be applied and administered as if the Line
9 Item Veto Act had not been enacted.
