## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to ensure that coverage of bone mass measurements is provided under the health benefits program for Federal employees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Osteoporosis Federal
- 5 Employee Health Benefits Standardization Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF BONE MASS MEASUREMENTS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 8902 of title 5, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
- 9 ing:

- 1 "(p)(1) A contract may not be made or a plan ap-
- 2 proved which does not include coverage for bone mass
- 3 measurement in the case of a qualified individual.
- 4 "(2) For purposes of this subsection, the terms 'bone
- 5 mass measurement' and 'qualified individual' shall each
- 6 have the meaning given to it by section 1861(rr) of the
- 7 Social Security Act, except that—
- 8 "(A) section 1861(rr)(2) of the Social Security
- 9 Act shall be applied by substituting 'the Director of
- the Office of Personnel Management' for 'the Sec-
- 11 retary'; and
- 12 "(B) standards regarding the frequency with
- which a qualified individual shall be eligible to be
- provided benefits for bone mass measurement under
- a health benefits plan under this chapter shall be
- established by the Director in consultation with the
- 17 Secretary of Health and Human Services.".
- 18 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 19 subsection (a) shall apply to bone mass measurements per-
- 20 formed on or after such date as the Office of Personnel
- 21 Management shall determine, except that such date shall
- 22 in no event be earlier than July 1, 1998, nor later than
- 23 January 1, 1999.
