For the relief of Roy Desmond Moser.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF EFFECTIVE DATE OF NATU-**  
4       **RALIZATION OF ROY DESMOND MOSER.**

5       Notwithstanding title III of the Immigration and Na-  
6       tionality Act, any predecessor provisions to such title, or  
7       any other provision of law relating to naturalization, for  
8       purposes of determining the eligibility of Roy Desmond  
9       Moser for relief under the Agreement Between the Gov-

1 ernment of the United States and the Government of the  
2 Federal Republic of Germany Concerning Final Benefits  
3 to Certain United States Nationals Who Were Victims of  
4 National Socialist Measures of Persecution, signed at  
5 Bonn on September 19, 1995, Roy Desmond Moser is  
6 deemed to be a naturalized citizen of the United States  
7 as of August 8, 1942.
