Mr. KOHL (for himself and Mr. FEINGOLD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To provide for the appointment of 1 additional Federal district judge for the eastern district of Wisconsin, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL FEDERAL DISTRICT JUDGE FOR**
4 **THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF WISCONSIN.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
6 “Wisconsin Federal Judgeship Act of 1997”.

7 (b) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint, by
8 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 addi-
9 tional district judge for the eastern district of Wisconsin.

1 (c) TABLES.—In order that the table contained in
 2 section 133 of title 28, United States Code, shall reflect
 3 the change in the total number of permanent district
 4 judgeships authorized under subsection (a), such table is
 5 amended by amending the item relating to Wisconsin to
 6 read as follows:

“Wisconsin:

“Eastern	5
“Western	2”.

7 (d) HOLDING OF COURT.—The chief judge of the
 8 eastern district of Wisconsin shall designate 1 judge who
 9 shall hold court for such district in Green Bay, Wisconsin.
