- 3 SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL FEDERAL DISTRICT JUDGE FOR
- 4 THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF WISCONSIN.
- 5 (a) Short Title.—This Act may be cited as the
- 6 "Wisconsin Federal Judgeship Act of 1997".
- 7 (b) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint, by
- 8 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 addi-
- 9 tional district judge for the eastern district of Wisconsin.

1	(c) Tables.—In order that the table contained in
2	section 133 of title 28, United States Code, shall reflect
3	the change in the total number of permanent district
4	judgeships authorized under subsection (a), such table is
5	amended by amending the item relating to Wisconsin to
6	read as follows:
	"Wisconsin: 5   "Eastern 5   "Western 2".

(d) HOLDING OF COURT.—The chief judge of the 7 eastern district of Wisconsin shall designate 1 judge who shall hold court for such district in Green Bay, Wisconsin.
