- 3 SECTION 1. REIMPORTATION OF CERTAIN GOODS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Subchapter I of chapter 98 of the
- 5 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
- 7 new subheading:
