For the relief of Dr. Yuri F. Orlov of Ithaca, New York.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELIEF OF DR. YURI F. ORLOV OF ITHACA, NEW
- 4 YORK.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 6 sion of law, Dr. Yuri F. Orlov of Ithaca, New York, shall
- 7 be deemed an annuitant as defined under section 8331(9)
- 8 of title 5, United States Code, and shall be eligible to re-
- 9 ceive an annuity.
- 10 (b) Computation.—For purposes of computing the
- 11 annuity described under subsection (a), Dr. Yuri F. Orlov
- 12 shall be deemed to—

| 1 | (1) have performed 40 years of creditable serv- |

| 2 | ice as a Federal employee; and |
| 3 | (2) received pay at the maximum rate payable |
| 4 | for a position above GS-15 of the General Schedule |
| 5 | (as in effect on the date of enactment of this Act) |
| 6 | for 3 consecutive years of such creditable service. |
| 7 | (c) Contributions.—No person shall be required to |
| 8 | make any contribution with respect to the annuity de- |
| 9 | scribed under subsection (a). |
| 10 | (d) Administrative Provisions.—The Director of |
| 11 | the Office of Personnel Management shall— |
| 12 | (1) apply the provisions of chapter 83 of title |
| 13 | 5, United States Code (including provisions relating |
| 14 | to cost-of-living-adjustments and survivor annuity |
| 15 | benefits) to the annuity described under subsection |
| 16 | (a) to the greatest extent practicable; and |
| 17 | (2) make the first payment of such annuity no |
| 18 | later than 60 days after the date of the enactment |
| 19 | of this Act. |
