A BILL

To provide a law enforcement exception to the prohibition on the advertising of certain electronic devices.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Law Enforcement
- 5 Technology Advertisement Clarification Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXCEPTION TO PROHIBITION ON ADVERTISING
- 7 CERTAIN DEVICES.
- 8 Section 2512 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(3) It shall not be unlawful under this section to
- 2 advertise for sale a device described in subsection (1) of
- 3 this section if the advertisement is mailed, sent, or carried
- 4 in interstate or foreign commerce solely to a domestic pro-
- 5 vider of wire or electronic communication service or to an
- 6 agency of the United States, a State, or a political subdivi-
- 7 sion thereof which is duly authorized to use such device.".
