Mr. Campbell introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To prohibit the cloning of humans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Human Cloning Prohi-
- 5 bition Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDING.
- 7 Congress finds that the Federal Government has a
- 8 moral obligation to the nation to prohibit the cloning of
- 9 humans.
- 10 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON HUMAN CLONING.
- 11 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for any per-
- 12 son to—

- 1 (1) clone a human being; or
- 2 (2) conduct research for the purpose of cloning
- a human being or otherwise creating a human em-
- 4 bryo.
- 5 (b) Federal Funds.—No Federal funds may be ob-
- 6 ligated or expended to knowingly conduct or support any
- 7 project of research the purpose of which is to clone a
- 8 human being or otherwise create a human embryo.
- 9 (c) Definition.—As used in subsection (a), the
- 10 terms "clone" and "cloning" mean the practice of creating
- 11 or attempting to create a human being by transferring the
- 12 nucleus from a human cell from whatever source into a
- 13 human egg cell from which the nucleus has been removed
- 14 for the purpose of, or to implant, the resulting product
- 15 to initiate a pregnancy that could result in the birth of
- 16 a human being.

17 SEC. 3. ENFORCEMENT.

- 18 (a) CIVIL PENALTIES.—Whoever is found to be in
- 19 violation of section 2 shall be subject to a civil penalty
- 20 of not more than \$5,000 for each such violation.
- 21 (b) Ineligibility for Federal Funds.—An indi-
- 22 vidual found to be in violation of section 2 shall not be
- 23 eligible to receive any Federal funding for research regard-

- 1 less of the type of research being conducted for a period
- 2 of 5 years after such violation.
