- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army shall
- 6 carry out a project under section 1135 of the Water Re-
- 7 sources Development Act of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2309a) at

- 1 the Eastern Channel of the Lockwoods Folly River,
- 2 Brunswick County, North Carolina.
- 3 (b) Project Features.—In carrying out the
- 4 project under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—
- 5 (1) open the Old Eastern Navigation Channel
- 6 at the mouth of the Lockwoods Folly River in
- 7 Brunswick County, North Carolina; and
- 8 (2) partially close the ocean channel between
- 9 the west end of Sheep Island and the northeast
- point of Holden Beach.
