## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on the synthetic organic

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON C.I. PIG-**  
4       **MENT YELLOW 110.**

7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
