A BILL

To amend section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Land Management Act of 1996 to provide additional funding for the preservation and restoration of historic buildings and structures at historically black colleges and universities, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR BUILDINGS AND**
4 **STRUCTURES AT HISTORICALLY BLACK COL-**
5 **LEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.**

6 Section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Land
7 Management Act of 1996 (16 U.S.C. 470a note; 110 Stat.

1 4156) is amended by striking subsection (d) and inserting
 2 the following:

3 “(d) FUNDING.—

4 “(1) AUTHORIZATION OF ADDITIONAL APPRO-
 5 PRIATIONS TO THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
 6 FUND.—In addition to other funds covered into the
 7 Historic Preservation Fund under section 108 of the
 8 National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f)
 9 or under any other law, there is authorized to be ap-
 10 propriated to the Historic Preservation Fund
 11 \$377,500,000 for fiscal years beginning after fiscal
 12 year 1998.

13 “(2) AVAILABILITY TO CARRY OUT THIS SEC-
 14 TION.—For fiscal years beginning after fiscal year
 15 1998, \$377,500,000 shall be made available pursu-
 16 ant to section 108 of the National Historic Preserva-
 17 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 470f) to carry out this section.”.
