 - 3 SECTION. 1. EXEMPTION OF LICENSED PHARMACISTS
 - 4 FROM SURETY BOND REQUIREMENTS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The last sentence of section
- 6 1834(a)(16) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 7 1395m(a)(16)) (as added by section 4312(c) of the Bal-
- 8 anced Budget Act of 1997 (Public Law 105–33; 111 Stat.
- 9 387)) is amended by inserting before the period at the

- 1 end the following: ", except that the Secretary may not
- 2 impose a surety bond described in subparagraph (B) of
- 3 that sentence on suppliers that are licensed pharmacies
- 4 for which the person signing the supplier application is
- 5 a licensed pharmacist under State law who has the author-
- 6 ity to bind the business entity".
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 8 subsection (a) takes effect as if included in the enactment
- 9 of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 (Public Law 105-
- 10 33; 111 Stat. 251).
