- 3 SECTION 1. BROADCAST MEDIA RATES.
- 4 Section 315(b) of the Communications Act of 1934
- 5 (47 U.S.C. 315(b)) is amended—
- 6 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting "if the com-
- 7 munication or advertisement is 1 minute or longer
- 8 and contains a clearly identifiable photographic or
- 9 similar image of the candidate during at least 75

- percent of the broadcast time" after "for the same period"; and

 (2) in paragraph (2), by inserting "and for
- communications other than those described in paragraph (1)" after "at any other time".
