## A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to create two divisions in the Eastern Judicial District of Louisiana.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CREATION OF TWO DIVISIONS.
- 4 Section 98(a) of title 28, United States Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "(a) The Eastern District comprises two divisions.
- 7 "(1) The New Orleans Division comprises the
- 8 parishes of Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, Saint
- 9 Bernard, Saint Charles, Saint John the Baptist,
- Saint Tammany, Tangipahoa, and Washington.

- 1 "Court for the New Orleans Division shall be
- 2 held at New Orleans.
- 3 "(2) The Houma Division comprises the par-
- 4 ishes of Assumption, Lafourche, Saint James, and
- 5 Terrebonne.
- 6 "Court for the Houma Division shall be held at
- 7 Houma.".

## 8 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 9 (a) In General.—This Act and the amendments
- 10 made by this Act shall take effect 180 days after the date
- 11 of the enactment of this Act.
- 12 (b) Pending Cases Not Affected.—This Act and
- 13 the amendments made by this Act shall not affect any ac-
- 14 tion commenced before the effective date of this Act and
- 15 pending on such date in the United States District Court
- 16 for the Eastern District of Louisiana or in the United
- 17 States District Court for the Western District of Louisi-
- 18 ana.
- 19 (c) Juries Not Affected.—This Act and the
- 20 amendments made by this Act shall not affect the com-
- 21 position, or preclude the service, of any grand or petit jury
- 22 summoned, impaneled, or actually serving on the effective
- 23 date of this Act.
