- 6 **DIUM SALT.**
- 7 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
- 8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

- 1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
- 2 new heading:

" 9902.31.12 Phosphonic acid, [[(phosphonomet-hyl)-imino]bis[2,1-ethanediylnitri-lobis(methyl-ene)][tetrakis-, sodium salt (CAS No. 22042–96–2) (provided for in subheading 2931.00.90) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2001 "

- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) applies with respect to articles entered, or
- 5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 6 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
