## A BILL

To provide for the conduct of a study and report concerning the ability of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to address the growing threat of viral epidemics and biological and chemical terrorism.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. STUDY CONCERNING THE CAPABILITIES OF
- 4 THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
- 5 PREVENTION.
- 6 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Health and Human
- 7 Services shall conduct a study concerning the ability of,
- 8 and resources available to, the Centers for Disease Control

- 1 and Prevention to address the growing threats of viral
- 2 epidemics and biologic and chemical terrorism.
- 3 (b) Report.—Not later than 60 days after the date
- 4 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
- 5 Human Services shall prepare and submit to the appro-
- 6 priate committees of Congress a report concerning the re-
- 7 sults of the study conducted under subsection (a), includ-
- 8 ing the recommendations of the Secretary for improving
- 9 the ability and resources of the Centers for Disease Con-
- 10 trol and Prevention to address the growing threats of viral
- 11 epidemics and biologic and chemical terrorism.
