3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PHENOL FORMALDEHYDE COPOLY-**
4 **MERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new item:

“	9902.39.14	Anion exchange resins based on copolymers of phenol/formaldehyde in primary form (provided for in sub-heading 3914.00.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2000	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 this section applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
