## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on polymethine sensitizing dyes for imaging applications.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**  
4 **TAIN SENSITIZING DYES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.29.34	Polymethine photo-sensitizing dyes (provided for in sub-headings 2934.90.90 and 2933.19.90) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,  
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of  
5 this Act.
