A BILL

To amend the National Sea Grant College Program Act with respect to the treatment of Lake Champlain.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF NATIONAL SEA GRANT COL-**
4 **LEGE PROGRAM ACT.**

5 Section 203 of the National Sea Grant College Pro-
6 gram Act (33 U.S.C. 1122) is amended by—

7 (1) striking paragraph (5) and redesignating
8 paragraphs (6) through (17) as paragraphs (5)
9 through (16);

1 (2) redesignating subparagraphs (C) through
2 (F) of paragraph (7), as redesignated, as subpara-
3 graphs (D) through (G); and

4 (3) inserting after subparagraph (B) of para-
5 graph (7), as redesignated, the following:

6 “(C) Lake Champlain (to the extent that
7 such resources have hydrological, biological,
8 physical, or geological characteristics and prob-
9 lems similar or related to those of the Great
10 Lakes);”.
