- 7 amended by striking "and 2902" and inserting "2902 and
- 8 2909.19.14".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—This amendment shall be-
- 10 come effective upon the date of enactment of this Act, and

- 1 shall apply to all drawback claims filed on and after such
- 2 date.
