A BILL

To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 to permit duty-free sales enterprises to be located in certain areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DUTY-FREE SALES ENTERPRISES.**

4 Section 555(b)(2) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
5 U.S.C. 1555(b)(2)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph
7 (A),

8 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
9 paragraph (B) and inserting “; or”, and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(C) the customs territory, if reasonable
4 assurance can be provided that the purchaser of
5 the duty-free merchandise will depart from an
6 international airport located within the customs
7 territory.”.
