## A BILL

To authorize the establishment of a disaster mitigation pilot program in the Small Business Administration.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. DISASTER MITIGATION PILOT PROGRAM.
4	(a) In General.—Section 7(b)(1) of the Small Busi-
5	ness Act (15 U.S.C. 636(b)(1)) is amended—
6	(1) in subparagraph (B), by adding "and" at
7	the end; and
8	(2) by adding at the end the following:
9	"(C) during fiscal years 1999 through 2003, to

establish a pre-disaster mitigation program to make

- 1 such loans (either directly or in cooperation with
- 2 banks or other lending institutions through agree-
- 3 ments to participate on an immediate or deferred
- 4 (guaranteed) basis), as the Administrator may deter-
- 5 mine to be necessary or appropriate, to enable small
- 6 businesses to install mitigation devices or to take
- 7 preventive measures to protect against disasters, in
- 8 support of a formal mitigation program established
- 9 by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, ex-
- cept that no loan or guarantee shall be extended to
- a small business under this subparagraph unless the
- Administration finds that the small business is oth-
- erwise unable to obtain credit for the purposes de-
- scribed in this subparagraph;".
- 15 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
- 16 20 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 note) is
- 17 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 18 "(f) Disaster Mitigation Pilot Program.—The
- 19 following program levels are authorized for loans under
- 20 section 7(b)(1)(C):
- "(1) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 1999.
- 22 "(2) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2000.
- "(3) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2001.
- "(4) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2002.

1 "(5) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2003.".
