AN ACT

For the relief of Marin Turcinovic, and his fiancee, Corina Dechalup.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 4 1101 et seq.), Marin Turcinovic and his fiancee, Corina
- 5 Dechalup, shall be held and considered to have been law-
- 6 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
- 7 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
- 8 payment of the required visa fees.

9 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 10 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Marin
- 11 Turcinovic and his fiancee, Corina Dechalup, as provided
- 12 in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
- 13 officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the
- 14 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
- 15 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
- 16 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 17 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
