2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.21	2-amino-6-methyl-5-(4-pyridinylthio) 4(1H)-Quinazolinone (CAS No. 147149-76-6) (provided for in sub-heading 2933.59.70)	Free	No Change	No Change	On or before 12/31/1999	”.
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1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-
 3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
 4 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
