- 2 DEATH BENEFITS.
- 3 (a) National Programs for Families of Public
- 4 SAFETY OFFICERS WHO HAVE DIED IN THE LINE OF
- 5 Duty.—Section 1203 of Part L of the Omnibus Crime
- 6 Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 379a-
- 7 1), is amended to read as follows: "The Director is author-
- 8 ized to use no less than \$150,000 of the funds appro-
- 9 priated for this part to maintain and enhance national
- 10 peer support and counseling programs to assist families
- 11 of public safety officers who have died in the line of duty.".
- 12 (b) Administrative Provision.—Section 1205 of
- 13 Part L of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets
- 14 Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796c), is amended by adding at
- 15 the end the following new subsection:
- 16 "(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 17 Bureau is authorized to use appropriated funds to conduct
- 18 appeals of public safety officers' death and disability
- 19 claims.".
