## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to adjust the formula used to determine cost limits for home health agencies under the Medicare program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Home Health
- 5 Equity Act of 1998".

#### 2 SEC. 2. REVISION OF HOME HEALTH INTERIM PAYMENT 2 FORMULA. 3 Cost Limits.—Section (a) RESTORATION OF 1861(v)(1)(L)(i)(IV) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 4 5 1395x(v)(1)(L)(i)(IV)) (as added by section 4602 of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997) is amended— 6 (1) by striking "105 percent" and inserting 7 8 "112 percent"; and (2) by striking "median" and inserting "mean". 9 10 (b) Change in Additions to Cost Limits.—Section 1861(v)(1)(L)(v) of the Social Security Act (42) 11 U.S.C. 1395x(v)(1)(L)(v) (as added by section 4602 of 13 the Balanced Budget Act of 1997) is amended to read as follows: 14 15 "(v)(I) For services furnished by home health agencies for cost reporting periods beginning on or after October 1, 1997, the Secretary shall provide for an interim 17 18 system of limits. - "(II) The labor-related portion of the updated national and regional costs described in subclause (I)(aa) shall be adjusted by the area wage index applicable under section 1886(d)(3)(E) for the area in which the agency is located (as determined without regard to any reclassification of the area under section 1886(d)(8)(B) or a decision of the Medicare Geographic Classification Review Board or the Secretary under section 1886(d)(10) for cost reporting periods beginning after October 1, 1995).".

- 14 SEC. 3. CBO ESTIMATE OF HOME HEALTH PAYMENT SAV-
- 15 INGS.
- 16 (a) Estimate.—Not later than 60 days after the
- 17 date of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter
- 18 until the prospective payment system for home health
- 19 agencies established by section 1895 of the Social Security
- 20 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395fff) is in effect, the Director of the
- 21 Congressional Budget Office (referred to in this section
- 22 as the "Director") shall estimate the amount of savings
- 23 to the Medicare program under title XVIII of such Act
- 24 (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.) resulting from the interim pay-
- 25 ment system for home health services established by the

- 1 amendments to section 1861 of such Act (42 U.S.C.
- 2 1395x) made by section 4602 of the Balanced Budget Act
- 3 of 1997.
- 4 (b) CERTIFICATION.—If the Director determines that
- 5 the amount estimated under subsection (a) exceeds the
- 6 amount of savings to the Medicare program that the Di-
- 7 rector estimated immediately prior to the enactment of the
- 8 Balanced Budget Act of 1997 by reason of such interim
- 9 payment system, then the Director shall certify such ex-
- 10 cess to the Secretary of Health and Human Services (re-
- 11 ferred to in this subsection as the "Secretary").
- 12 (c) Adjustment.—
- 13 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the Director certifies an
- amount to the Secretary pursuant to subsection (b),
- the Secretary shall prescribe rules under which ap-
- propriate adjustments are made to the amount of
- payments to home health agencies otherwise made
- under subparagraph (L) of section 1861(v)(1) of the
- Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(v)(1)(L)) (as
- amended by section 4602 of the Balanced Budget
- Act of 1997) in the case of outliers—
- (A) where events beyond the home health
- agency's control or extraordinary cir-
- cumstances, including the case mix of such
- agency, create reasonable costs for a payment

- year which exceed the applicable payment limits; or
  - (B) in any case not described in subparagraph (A) where the Secretary deems such an adjustment appropriate.
  - (2) Amount.—The total amount of adjustments made under paragraph (2) for a year may not exceed the amount certified to the Secretary pursuant to subsection (b) for such year. To the extent that such adjustments in a year would otherwise exceed the amount certified to the Secretary pursuant to subsection (b) for such year, the Secretary shall reduce the payments to home health agencies in a pro rata manner so that the adjustments do not exceed such amount.

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
