A BILL

To provide for the elimination of duty on Ziram.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DUTY ON ZIRAM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 3808.20.24 of the
5 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by striking “and Metiram” and inserting
7 “Metiram; and Ziram”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
10 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
11 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
