Mr. INOUE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Dogan Umut Evans.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RELATIVE STATUS FOR DOGAN**  
4       **UMUT EVANS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Dogan Umut Evans shall be clas-  
6       sified as a child under section 101(b)(1)(F) of the Immi-  
7       gration and Nationality Act for purposes of approval of  
8       a relative visa petition filed under section 204 of such Act  
9       by his adoptive parent and the filing of an application for  
10      an immigrant visa or adjustment of status.

11      (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Dogan Umut  
12      Evans enters the United States before the filing deadline

1 specified in subsection (c), he shall be considered to have  
 2 entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligi-  
 3 ble, be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245  
 4 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of  
 5 the enactment of this Act.

6 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
 7 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the pe-  
 8 tition and the application for issuance of an immigrant  
 9 visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed  
 10 with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the  
 11 enactment of this Act.

12 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
 13 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
 14 idence to Dogan Umut Evans, the Secretary of State shall  
 15 instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, for the current  
 16 or next following fiscal year, the worldwide level of family-  
 17 sponsored immigrants under section 201(c)(1)(A) of the  
 18 Immigration and Nationality Act.

19 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
 20 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural  
 21 parents, brothers, and sisters of Dogan Umut Evans, if  
 22 any, shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded  
 23 any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and  
 24 Nationality Act.
