A BILL

To clarify the authority of the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation regarding the collection of fees to process certain identification records and name checks, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Gun Tax Act of
5 1998”.

1 **SEC. 2. IDENTIFICATION RECORDS AND NAME CHECKS**
2 **FEEES.**

3 The first paragraph under the subheading “SALARIES
4 AND EXPENSES” under the heading “FEDERAL BU-
5 REAU OF INVESTIGATION” in title II of Public Law
6 101–515 (28 U.S.C. 534 note) is amended by adding at
7 the end thereof the following new sentence:

8 “Notwithstanding the foregoing or any other provision of
9 law, the Director may not collect any fee, assessment,
10 third party collection, or other charge from any person or
11 agency in connection with any background check required
12 under subsections (s) or (t) of section 922 of title 18,
13 United States Code.”.
