## A BILL

To provide for air transportation between Denver, Colorado, and London, England.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AIR SERVICE BETWEEN DENVER, COLORADO,**

4                       **AND LONDON, ENGLAND.**

5       (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6               (1) AIR CARRIER.—The term “air carrier” has  
7       the meaning given that term in section 40102(2) of  
8       title 49, United States Code.

1           (2) AIR TRANSPORTATION.—The term “air  
2           transportation” has the meaning given that term in  
3           section 40102(5) of title 49, United States Code.

4           (b) PROVISION OF FOREIGN AIR TRANSPORTATION  
5 BETWEEN DENVER, COLORADO, AND LONDON, ENG-  
6 LAND.—

7           (1) IN GENERAL.—In a manner consistent with  
8           applicable law, not later than July 1, 1998, an air  
9           carrier may provide nonstop air transportation be-  
10          tween Denver, Colorado, and London, England.

11          (2) ACTIONS BY SECRETARY OF TRANSPOR-  
12          TATION.—The Secretary of Transportation shall  
13          take such actions as may be necessary to provide for  
14          the implementation of paragraph (1).
