## A BILL

To provide for air transportation between Denver, Colorado, and London, England.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. AIR SERVICE BETWEEN DENVER, COLORADO,

AND LONDON, ENGLAND.

(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

(1) AIR CARRIER.—The term "air carrier" has

the meaning given that term in section 40102(2) of

title 49, United States Code.

1	(2) AIR TRANSPORTATION.—The term "air
2	transportation" has the meaning given that term in
3	section 40102(5) of title 49, United States Code.
4	(b) Provision of Foreign Air Transportation
5	Between Denver, Colorado, and London, Eng-
6	LAND.—
7	(1) In general.—In a manner consistent with
8	applicable law, not later than July 1, 1998, an air
9	carrier may provide nonstop air transportation be-
10	tween Denver, Colorado, and London, England.
11	(2) Actions by secretary of transpor-
12	TATION.—The Secretary of Transportation shall
13	take such actions as may be necessary to provide for
14	the implementation of paragraph (1).
