## AN ACT

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Arkansas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES.

- 2 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
- 3 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), the Federal En-
- 4 ergy Regulatory Commission, upon the request of the li-
- 5 censee for FERC Project No. 10455 (and after reasonable
- 6 notice), is authorized, in accordance with the good faith,
- 7 due diligence and public interest requirements of section
- 8 13 and the Commission's procedures under such section,
- 9 to extend the time required for commencement of con-
- 10 struction of the project for up to a maximum of three con-
- 11 secutive two-year periods. This section shall take effect for
- 12 the project upon the expiration of the extension (issued
- 13 by the Commission under section 13) of the period re-
- 14 quired for commencement of such project.
